
Characteristics of Blockchain entries of transactions and events



- Occurrence. Transactions and events that have been recorded have definitively occurred.
- Accuracy. Amounts and other data relating to recorded transactions and events have been measured and recorded appropriately.
- Completeness. All transactions and events that should have been recorded have been recorded.
- Existence. Transactions and events have occurred as evidenced by peer-to-peer engagement via private and public keys.
- Understandability. Transactions and events have been presented in both transparent and traceable manner.
- Valuation. Transaction values have been validated via a rigorous mining or validation process.
- Rights and obligations. Rights and obligations are expressed within smart contracts.
- **Cut-off**. Transactions and events have been **time-stamped** for correctness of period.
- ensured transactions and events are executed in the correct order.
