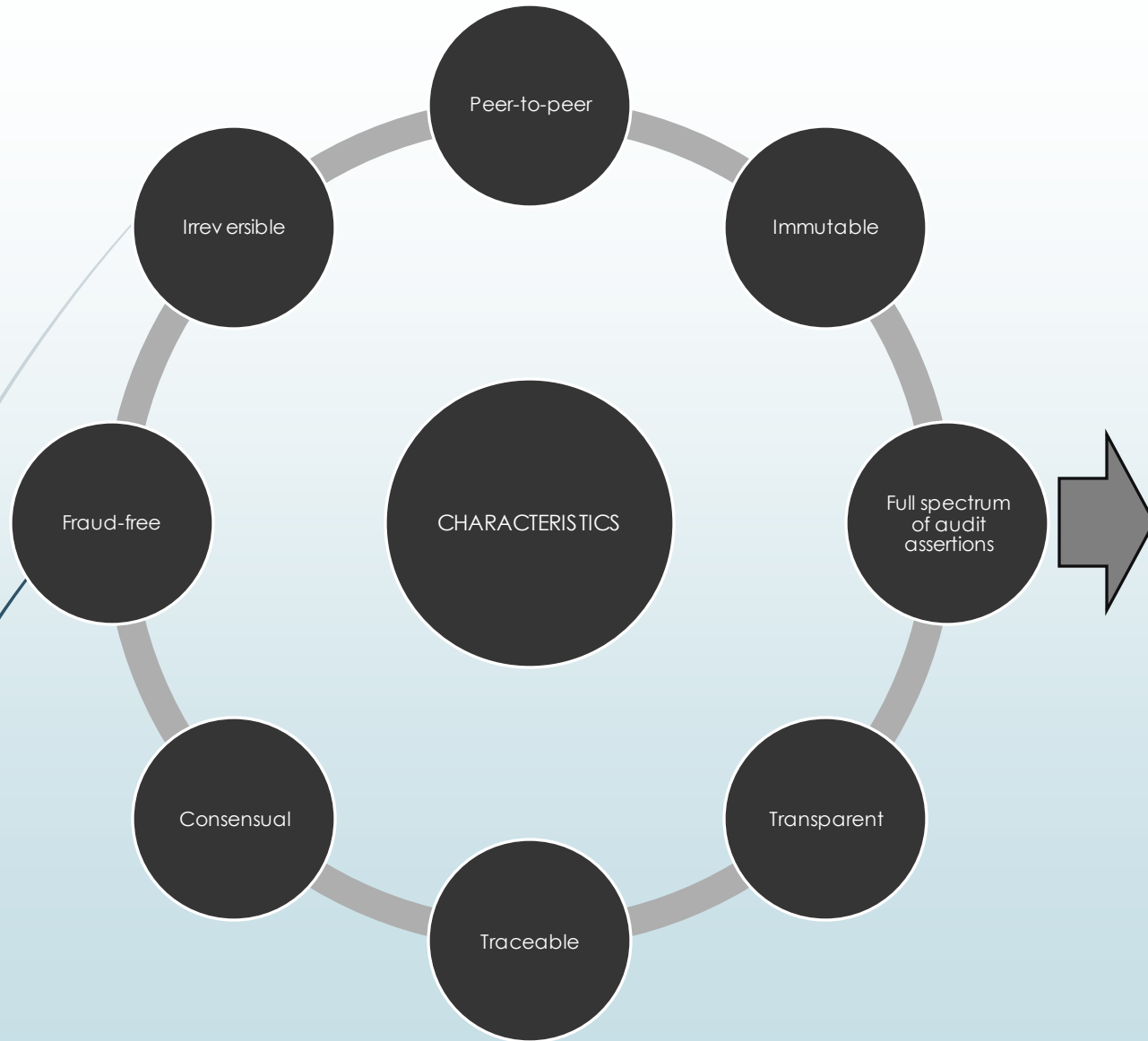


Characteristics of Blockchain entries of transactions and events



- **Occurrence.** Transactions and events that have been recorded have **definitively** occurred.
- **Accuracy.** Amounts and other data relating to recorded transactions and events have been **measured and recorded appropriately.**
- **Completeness.** **All** transactions and events that should have been recorded have been recorded.
- **Existence.** Transactions and events have occurred as evidenced by **peer-to-peer engagement** via private and public keys.
- **Understandability.** Transactions and events have been presented in both **transparent** and **traceable** manner.
- **Valuation.** Transaction values have been validated via a rigorous **mining** or **validation** process.
- **Rights and obligations.** Rights and obligations are expressed within **smart contracts.**
- **Cut-off.** Transactions and events have been **time-stamped** for correctness of period.
- **Classification. Sequencing** has ensured transactions and events are executed in the correct order.
